

While reflecting on our achievements in 2023, one word comes to mind: Momentum. This represents the strength and progress we've gained from our continuous efforts. We all understand the importance of planning, energy, and execution to build momentum. We also know the challenges of maintaining or increasing our pace amid external pressures. From this perspective, I am proud to share that 2023 was the year in which we made our biggest impact in the fight against water poverty, with a record number of projects successfully deployed and a record number of beneficiaries reached.

A large contributing factor to this has been our commitment to the international expansion of our safe drinking water projects and, in particular, our disaster response work. In total, in 2023, we deployed 252 projects providing safe drinking water access to over 750,000 people across 18 countries, another record for us in terms of the most countries covered in a calendar year.


This included large-scale responses to natural disasters with our AquaBlock emergency water system, with a total of 38 systems deployed to provide support after major earthquakes in Türkiye and Morocco, flooding in Libya, and Hurricane Otis – a Category 5 storm that devastated Acapulco, Mexico.

Our ability to expand all our programs is made possible by the ongoing commitments of our long-term partners and new partners. In 2023, we were honored to welcome Avnet, Carter's, Hilton, Microsoft, and PromoCares as partners who share our commitment to improving community health with clean, safe drinking water and hygiene education programs that break the needless cycle of water poverty.

In closing, momentum is achieved by many internal and external forces. We are thankful for every effort made to move Planet Water Foundation forward and, more importantly, recognize that our combined efforts are converting momentum into energy for change.

Our global coverage consists of operational countries, partner countries, and locations where emergency response work was undertaken in 2023. Altogether, we deployed systems in 18 countries in 2023. While most of these partnerships are designed for the long-term, some are special purpose partnerships, such as the projects in Ghana.



## AQUATOWER

Our flagship solution is the AquaTower, a community-based, water filtration system that supports the daily drinking water requirements of up to 1,800 people. The AquaTower is recognizable and welcomed in communities worldwide as a reliable source of clean, safe drinking water and handwashing stations for school children, families, and community members.

AquaTower projects involve the construction and commissioning of a 3-stage, ultrafiltration (UF) water filtration system along with the implementation of our activity-based, Water-Health and Hygiene Education program in schools. In 2023, a total of 193 AquaTower projects were deployed across 13 countries.











## DISASTER RESPONSE

Natural disasters such as earthquakes, floods, typhoons, hurricanes, cyclones, and volcanic eruptions threaten life in their aftermath as much as the moment. These disasters destroy water and sanitation infrastructure, and subsequently increase the risk of waterborne diseases amongst impacted communities. When they strike, response time is critical to improving the odds of survival.

With these situations in mind, Planet Water's AquaBlock is designed as a rapid response solution to provide emergency access to safe drinking water at the point of need. The AquaBlock has a revolutionary design, efficient footprint, and can be airlifted, positioned and commissioned for service within hours. Each system provides clean, safe drinking water from nearly any source for up to 10,000 people per day under the most difficult conditions.











#### February 2023 TÜRKIYE



An early morning earthquake on February 6 claimed the lives of approximately 50,000 people in Türkiye and affected 13.5 million people. With thousands trapped in unstable buildings or rubble of apartment homes, the people of Türkiye needed urgent support in response to the disaster.

Planet Water mobilized 16 AquaBlock systems from its global logistics hub and airlifted them to Istanbul where they were transported by road to the disaster zones. With the support of our strategic deployment partner Xylem, Planet Water Foundation staff deployed systems in evacuation camps to provide much needed safe drinking water.



#### September 2023 MOROCCO



The Marrakesh-Safi earthquake in Morocco leveled many of the communities nestled around the Atlas Mountains, leaving hundreds of families with little hope seeking refuge in makeshift settlements. The response from Planet Water involved the airlifting of six AquaBlock systems to Casablanca and then positioning them within the disaster zone. Planet Water disaster response team members arrived in Morocco to manage positioning and installation in communities where the systems could provide the greatest benefit.





#### November 2023 MEXICO



Hurricane Otis arrived on the southern shores of Acapulco, Mexico in the early morning of October 25. Landslides and floods created by the category 5 storm with 270mk/h winds destroyed the drinking water supply, making waterborne diseases a serious threat.

Overall, Planet Water Foundation deployed a total of 10 water filtration systems to communities across the impacted areas.


